

What happens - Assessment



Initial Contact

You will get in touch with us via phone, website or email.

During this we tend to want to understand and make sure an OT Assessment is right. We will often share some dates and times we can do.



Forms

We will start sending out forms for you to complete. This will also include school/learning place or other people who you have asked us to consult with. We will get in touch to arrange a feedback meeting for after the assessment date.



Scoring and Feedback

When you leave the Occupational Therapist will score the assessment and start writing the report.

We will meet around the child to discuss the assessment. We can also meet with the young person to share what this all means too.

During this waiting the final payment of the invoice is paid.



Consent

Once we've agreed a date and time. We will send out a consent form for you to complete. Following this we send an invoice which you should pay at least 50% to confirm the booking.



Assessment day

The assessment day will come and on the day we do a mix of things. Often this includes 'sitting down' activities and a mix of freeplay. This forms our assessment.



The Occupational Therapist will keep writing. Once this has finished the report is proof read by another member of the team.

The report is shared with you to make sure it is accurate before being finalised.

We will ask if needed if you would like to have therapy and be clear on how much the 'block' of therapy recommended would be.
